## See Change in My Community

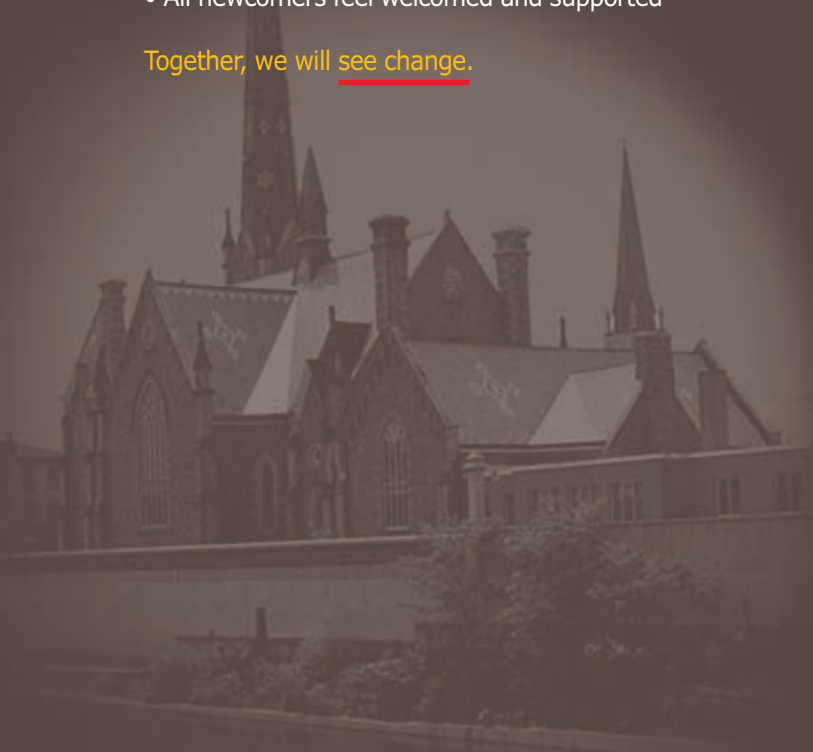

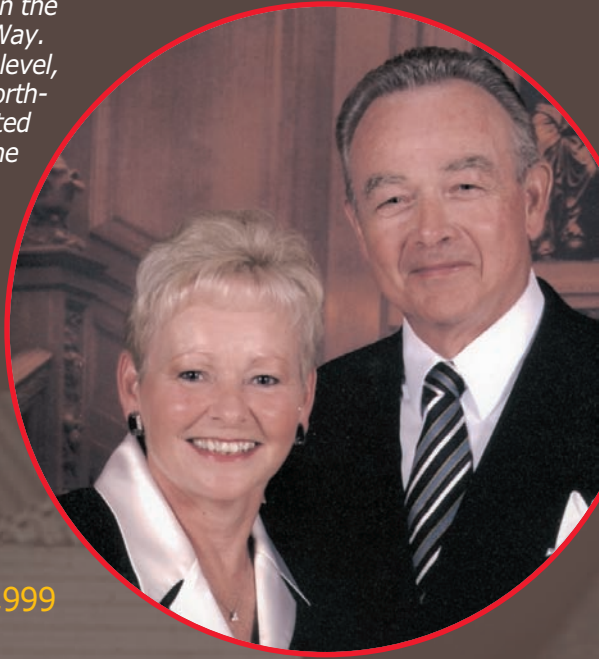
